# East Norfolk CAMRA Social

This trail consists of 6 pubs around the Market Place area. It is a 1.5 mile walk going through the market place twice for those in need of food on the way. Starting at The Mariners at 12pm and finishing at Tombstone Saloon Bar, we will be spending around 45 minutes in each bar so if you can't make it at the start don't worry you can catch us up.

1	<b>Mariners Tavern</b> 🍷	 <p>The Mariners</p>
<p>Family run local comprising a main bar and a smaller wood panelled lounge complete with pool table. An annual beer festival is held to coincide with the Yarmouth maritime weekend in September. There is a small selection of foreign beers and many of the seven guest ales are from local micros.</p>		
2	<b>Feathers</b>	 <p>The Feathers</p>
<p>Adjacent to the market place, this pub has traditional wooden floors, a real fire and friendly atmosphere. Very busy on market days (Wed. and Sat. plus Fri. in summer), bar snacks are available and full roast on Sunday.</p>		
3	<b>The Lion</b>	
<p>Good old-fashioned local with two bars, sited opposite the Beach coach station, between the sea front and the town centre. Usually has two real ales on.</p>		
4	<b>Oliver Twist</b> 🍷	
<p>Corner local close to the market. A varying selection of cask ales plus ciders and perries. Entertainment every weekend.</p>		
5	<b>Coachmakers Arms</b>	
<p>Single room full of character(s) overlooking the market place and parish church. Close to Anna Sewell House and the Fisherman's Hospital. Live music Wednesday, Saturday 3-6pm, also Friday in summer to coincide with market days. Has a model tram on display, and a noisy parrot. Tiled sign from when it was a Lacon's pub.</p>		
6	<b>Tombstone Saloon</b>	
<p>Old West style bar specialising in real ale and cider, operated by the local Tombstone Brewery which is sited at the rear of the premises. Staff are friendly and knowledgeable about beer, and there are usually up to six Tombstone real ales plus four others from local breweries.</p>
